However, in the period 2016-2020, the provincial competitiveness index in recent years has tended to decrease and has not reached the goal of being stable in the top 10 localities with the best governance quality. This reflects the reality of the Red River Delta provinces. Although there have been efforts to improve the investment and business environment, the solutions proposed and the implementation of departments, branches, districts, The city and relevant agencies and units still have many limitations and have yet to see improvements and breakthroughs. Therefore, the Red River Delta provinces need to take specific actions to gradually improve the investment environment and competitiveness of the provinces. 2. Overview of the Provincial Competitiveness Index (PCI)

The Provincial Competitiveness Index (PCI), for short, was built to evaluate the business environment, quality of economic management, and administrative reform efforts of the governments of provinces and cities in the country. Vietnam. Not only focusing on analyzing businesses' perceptions about the quality of economic governance, the annual PCI study also conducts surveys on foreign-invested (FDI) businesses operating in Vietnam. Assess business confidence about business prospects, rate the quality of local infrastructure, and conduct thematic research on a prominent trend or policy that has a major impact on production and business activities. Businesses across the country. PCI is the result of research cooperation between the Vietnam Chamber of Commerce and Industry (VCCI) and the United States Agency for International Development since 2005.

PCI is determined through a system of component indices. Each component index has a weight and includes a number of constituent indicators, reflecting different fields and aspects of government at all levels that directly affect the production and business activities of the enterprise.

3. Comparison with Provinces in the Red River Delta, Provinces in the Group of 5 Provinces and Cities Top the Country in Pci Scores

3.1 PCI score

Vinh Phuc province's PCI index ranks third in the Red River Delta region, after Quang Ninh and Hai Phong. These are two localities in the group of five provinces and cities leading the country in terms of PCI scores (Quang Ninh ranked 1st and Hai Phong ranked 2nd nationwide). Thus, the total PCI score of Vinh Phuc province is only behind the first and second two provinces and cities nationwide in the region.

3.2 Market Entry Index

Vinh Phuc province's 2021 Market Entry Index ranked 28/63 provinces and cities with 7.02 points, down 14 places.

4. Lessons Learned from Provinces and Cities in Improvement of the PCI Index

- Promote propaganda work on mass media so that businesses understand the ways and benefits of carrying out online business registration procedures.
- Continue to promote administrative procedure reform with the goal of 3 reductions: reduce time, procedures and costs.
- Improve the sense of responsibility and service attitude of the staff and civil servants in the receiving and guiding department when carrying out administrative procedures.
- Strengthen propaganda and promote the content of commitments and benefits of FTAs that Vietnam has signed to the business community. Improve the quality of information provided on industry websites about support procedures.
- There needs to be mechanisms and policies to support businesses that are close to reality, achieve the highest efficiency, and in accordance with legal regulations;
- It is necessary to strengthen the organization of trade promotion activities, creating opportunities for businesses to access information, mechanisms and State policies.

- Departments, committees and branches need to be more proactive in coordination to improve the PCI index; Further promote information and propaganda of guidelines, policies, and procedures to support businesses to production facilities and businesses in the province.
- Implement stable and consistent land policies, especially in compensation and site clearance.
