husband and wife show signs of decline. The marriage relationships of some young families have become fragile, due to being dominated by an open, pragmatic lifestyle, pursuing material benefits, causing the divorce rate to increase rapidly in recent years. The relationship between parents, grandparents and children shows a lack of cohesion, due to the narrowing of living space and family communication, and personal needs and interests are emphasized. Many fathers and mothers do not fulfill their duties and responsibilities, do not care for future generations, and there are also many adversities in which children lack responsibility towards their parents and grandparents, are filial, and unjust. Sibling relationships also arise instabilities, sometimes just because of money or small, trivial benefits, the brotherly relationship is lost. Due to calculations of greater profits and personal interests, the love of the village and neighbors has somewhat diminished. Some families do not pay attention to education, or are interested but are confused about both content and methods, causing many consequences, especially the deterioration of family and social morality. In fact, in recent years, the number of murders occurring in families accounts for 18% -20%, some cases are just for economic gain or small conflicts and frictions. What is worrying is the recent trend of rejuvenating murder criminals, when up to 60% of the subjects are under the age of 30 [4]... Rate of crimes committed by teenagers across the country is 5.2% for people under 14 years old, 24.5% for people from 14 to under 16 years old and 70.3% for people from 16 to under 18 years old [5]. These phenomena are ringing a wake-up call for every family and the whole society, because the consequences they cause are extremely painful and painful, seriously affecting the moral foundation of the society and personality of modern Vietnamese people.

Continue to promote the traditional values of the Vietnamese family in the spirit of the Resolution of the 13th Party Congress
